Dr. Barnhorst attended medical school and completed her psychiatric at UC Davis. She then joined the faculty and is now the Medical Director of Crisis Services for Sacramento County. She runs a county crisis unit and adjacent a 50-bed inpatient facility that provides emergency and acute psychiatric care for a largely homeless and indigent population with serious mental illness.

Dr. Barnhorst's academic interests include violence and suicide prevention, firearm policy, and community mental health delivery systems. She is a member of the Sierra Sacramento Valley Medical Society Mental Health Task Force, the Consortium for Risk-Based Firearm Policy and the California Medical Society Firearm Violence Prevention Committee. She has written multiple papers on firearms, mental illness and the law, and has testified before the California Senate on these issues.
